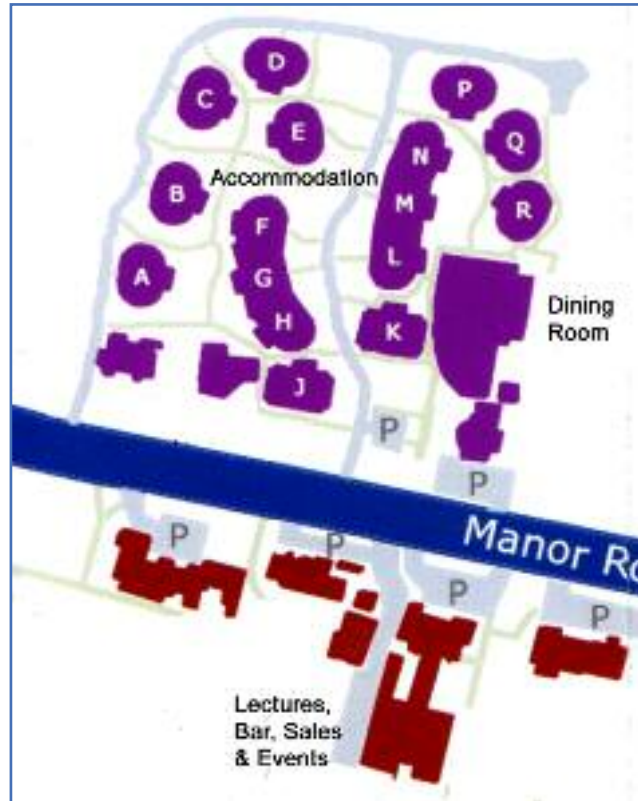

The Venue



The Gilbert Murrey Conference Suite is a purpose-built facility adjacent to high quality single room accommodation.
